



Welcome to Ammon, the city "Where Tomorrow Begins". Ammon is located in the Upper Snake River Valley. Its western boundary touches the City of Idaho Falls.

Foothills and mountains outline Ammon's eastern and southern skies. The Caribou National Forest with its Blackfoot Mountain range begins ten miles to the south and its rugged Caribou Mountain Range lies 20 miles to the east.

Ammon is one of Idaho's fastest growing cities. Based on the 2020 Census, the City of Ammon's population is 17,694, and is currently the State of Idaho's 15th largest city.

The city's rapid growth is due to its availability of open space for affordable residential housing and the city's hometown lifestyle, as well as its near proximity to the urban amenities and job market in Idaho Falls.

Within an hour's drive from the city, opportunities abound for boating, rafting, canoeing, hunting, fishing, camping, snow and water skiing, snowmobiling, and ice fishing.
